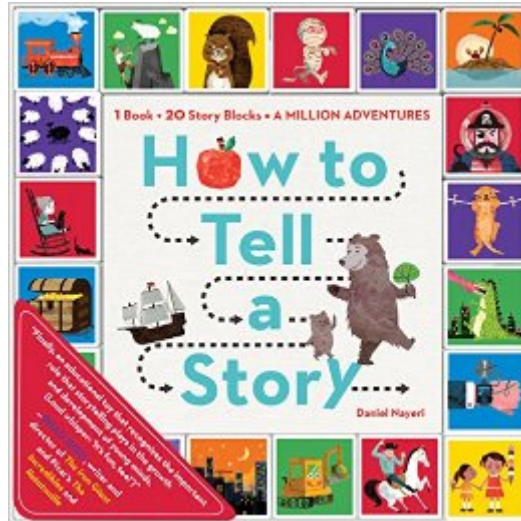

A simple exercise about motivation, for example, asks the reader to roll the blocks and find one red block (person or animal) â€”who wanted nothing more in this world than toâ€”one green block (action). Depending on the outcome, the reader might end up telling a tale of a cowboy who just wanted to dance or a mummy who wanted to race cars. How to Tell a Story combines the surprising whimsy of Mad Libs with the compelling fun of storytelling cubes. Its exercises and games will have readers mastering the basics of storytelling while exercising their creative muscles. And who knows where that journey will end? Â
